COVID PROTOCOL

Parents who are entering the studio to come pay tuition, please wear a face covering.

Dancers can wear a face covering entering and exiting the studio. Dancers are not required to wear a mask while dancing as the numbers on the dance floor are appropriately social distanced. The BADC has lanyards for \$2.00 that dancers can purchase to hold their mask while dancing, or you may bring your own. This will help dancers keep their own mask with them at all times so they can be worn during transitions if needed.

Social Distancing will be adhered to.

The BADC will be sanitizing surfaces, door handles, cubbies, and floor daily. Hand sanitizer will be available for dancers at their cubbies.

The BADC will follow the COVID protocol outlined by the Indian River School District.

**DO NOT come to class if your dancer or immediate family member is experiencing any of these symptoms.

- Fever of 100.4 F or more
- Chills
- New cough, nasal congestion, or runny nose
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- New muscle or body aches, or fatigue
- Headache (if abnormal for you)
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain
- Diarrhea
- New rash (for students)
